 the "Atlantic Monthly" in 1862.

"No wealth can buy the requisite leisure, freedom, and
 independence which are the capital in this profession.
 It comes only by the grace of God. It requires a direct
 dispensation from Heaven to become a walker.

I think that I cannot preserve my health and spirits,
 unless I spend four hours a day at least, and it is
 commonly more than that, sauntering through the woods
 and over the hills and fields, absolutely free from all
 worldly engagements. When sometimes I am reminded that
 the mechanics and shopkeepers stay in their shops not
 only all the forenoon, but all the afternoon, too, sitting
 with crossed legs, so many of them, as if their legs were
 made to sit upon, and not to stand or walk upon, I think
 that they deserve some credit for not having all committed
 suicide long ago."

Editors note -- certainly Thoreau, born July 12, 1817, would
 have been a runner had he not been born 162 years too soon.

The Hoosier Road Running Club/Indiana Striders is an organization of runners and joggers in Indiana. The club has been in existence for over 7 years. The main contact with the members is through the Hoosier Runner, a monthly newsletter. Membership in the HRRC also makes you an affiliated member of the Road Running Club of America. They publish a quarterly newsletter called Footnotes. The Hoosier Runner lists a quite complete schedule of races, carries entry forms and publishes race results. You can save the postage of writing for entry blanks by using those in the HR. Some sporting goods stores recognize the Hoosier Runner membership card by allowing a 10% discount. You can save the price of your membership in the purchase of some running gear.

Membership is offered for 12 months beginning with your first issue of the Hoosier Runner. With your first issue you will receive a membership card.

The goals of the club are to promote running in Indiana and to serve as a common meeting ground or forum for all Indiana runners and joggers. The club encourages younger runners by offering lower membership rates to students. To compensate for the financial loss this represents, we have opened a category called the "Hoosier Hero" to enable the more financially able runners to contribute to the development of younger runners.

As of January, 1980, all members will receive the Hoosier Runner by first class mail.
