

LEAMON RUN WAS GREAT FUN!

Although they raised \$511.10, I think the 124 participants in the "Walk, Run or Roll for Nat Leamon" may very well have received more than they gave. For one thing, everyone who finished received a beautiful winners ribbon and a hug from my mother.

Nat was a "double dipper." Not only was his wheelchair bank account fattened, he seemed to have a wonderful time at his 1 1/3 mile party. His minister pushed Nat until he tired. Then my sister, Laura York, in clown and roller skates took over. What fun!

Mindy Smith, a sixth grader who already has a wheelchair like Nat needs was absolutely beaming as she crossed the finish line.

Vicki Cayot walked the whole distance although she was 9 months pregnant. Fortunately, her beautiful baby boy wasn't born until Memorial Day.

Lon Buuck, the Ossian School principal, ran, walked and talked the whole distance in a bear suit. He was wonderful. The little ones especially enjoyed him, but no more than he enjoyed them.

It's a good thing there wasn't a bank robbery that morning. Half the police force was doing a superb job of traffic control. The other half participated in the run. The three year old son of the town marshal who was watching the whole thing at the half way point decided to join in the fun. His mother finally caught up with him at the finish line.

The Psi Iota Xi Sorority who paid half the expenses, put up balloons and did the registration had a great time walk and jogging together.

The two ladies in their 60's who regularly walk in the school gym before school were thrilled to have walked the distance better than quite a few children ran it.

The course turn around was in the parking lot of Ossian Health Care. Merv Ellis, a resident, did a great job of keeping everyone straightened out.

Rodney Obergon of the F.W.T.C. family was the first runner across the finish line. Brian and Michael Lindley also well represented the F.W.T.C. Their dad took up a collection of \$56 at the Prediction Run.

The "stars" of the event were Butch Martin and Max Rhoades. They were wonderfully warm and gracious especially with the kids. They really enriched the lives of my students and won themselves quite a fan club.

My class, the Ossian Running Bears, put an incredible amount of work into this project for Second Graders. They wrote dozens of letters, made 20 posters, blew up balloons and made a huge start-finish banner. They probably are the most giving class I've ever had and to a large extent they were rewarded for their efforts. Barbara Barbieri of the Bluffton News-Banner did a wonderful two page picture article about their run. They received lots of compliments on the ribbons they designed. They had a ball like everyone else that morning. Max Rhoades brought 5 Florida t-shirts which were awarded to them by drawing. However, none of this was as significant as their sense of accomplishment and pride in seeing what they planned successfully carried out, supported and enjoyed by so many.

Although Bobby and I worked literally hundred of races, I had no idea until I came close to being the race director of this one what a job race directing is! I poured at least two weeks of my life into this event. But its still true that what you give is what you get. Before the race, my students surprised me with a rose. "Run for the Roses" is one of Bobby's favorite songs. It's even better to have the roses before one begins. You can't hardly beat winning before you cross the starting line!

As is often the case, the best story of this event may be the last one. Phil Shafer, who was quite active in the F.W.T.C. a few years ago, was seriously injured in an auto accident last year. His brother-in-law, who was injured in the same accident, did the whole 1 1/2 miles on crutches. These two who were last definitely were not least to those of us clapping at the finish line. Coming so close to never starting another fun run puts a whole new perspective on just participating not only for the participants but also for those who care about them.

Jim Bushey is right about us needing more participation events like this. Any piece of asphalt will do for our soles, but we need more events like this that put a glow on our souls.

Here's an opportunity to participate in a race with an exciting twist! The Fourth Annual Amusement Park Run offers your club a chance to compete on one of the most unusual race courses in the Midwest. What's more, after the race, you'll be able to enjoy an entire day of fun at Cedar Point. (Park hours will be 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.)

Sponsored by Trustcorp, Inc. for the second consecutive year, The Amusement Park Run will be held on Sunday, Sept. 7. 

Q: I have a friend whom I suspect may have an eating disorder. She runs a lot even when she has an injury, her weight is low yet she is very concerned about gaining weight, she talks about skipping meals, she doesn't eat meat and when we eat together she eats only a small salad from the salad bar, if at all. I'm concerned about what she may be doing to herself but I don't know how to help her.

A: It sounds like you may have good reason to be concerned, however, we do know that treatment is most effective when the person involved seeks treatment for themselves. As a friend, there are some very helpful things you can do and one of the most important is to be supportive of your friend. People who recover from an eating disorder are assisted by their support systems (family and friends) who are there during the sometimes long recovery period. There are other things you can do, also.

Educate yourself about eating disorders. Learn to identify the warning signs and symptoms. These include: Abnormally low weight of 25% below Ideal Body Weight with no known medical illness, reduction in food intake, denial of hunger (until they no longer can identify when they are hungry), decrease in consumption of high-carbohydrate and fat-containing foods, prolonged exercise despite fatigue or injury, intense fear of gaining weight, distorted body image, peculiar patterns of handling foods and food combinations, social withdrawal, amenorrhea, self-induced vomiting, laxative and/or diuretic abuse, and an eating pattern that alternates between binges or overeating and fasts.

Do some reading concerning eating disorders (Anorexia Nervosa, Bulimia or Bulimarexia). There are popular books and articles at the public library or bookstore.

Share with your friend your concern about her health without preaching or labeling. Share with her any books or articles that you've read that might be helpful to her. Person's with eating disorders (they can also be men or boys), are very secretive about their eating habits. Allow your friend to be embarrassed and understand her possible defensiveness while also letting her know that you are available to help if you can.

You can obtain more information through a community support group for eating disorder sufferers, family and/or friends. You may want to attend a few meetings yourself to get more guidance. The support group meets Wednesday's from 5:30 to 6:30 PM at St. Joseph's Hospital. Call 425-3663 for location or more information.






