Legwork aimed at Congress

VAN WERT, Ohio (AP) — John Eakin is running for a bill in Congress — all the way from Washington state to Washington, D.C. — at 30 to 35 miles a day.

On a recent morning, he left a motel here at 6:30 a.m., aiming to check in at another one at Beaverdam, Ohio, about 3 p.m. He planned to run most of the way, walking maybe two miles of the distance.

Eakin began his run June 7 and hopes to finish Sept. 12. His aim is to increase public awareness of a bill that Congress is to vote on next month called the Universal Child Immunization Act.

IT PROPOSES that the U.S. government provide \$50 million in 1987 on a worldwide effort to immunize children, especially those in the Third World.

The immunizations are the same most American children receive before starting school: for diphtheria, measles, whooping cough, polio, tuberculosis and tetanus.

Eakin, 34, a postal worker from Fort Wayne, Ind., hopes his run will spark letter-writing campaigns to Congress for passage of the bill.

He made similar runs the past four summers, although he has never attempted to run cross-country. His earlier ventures were aimed at increasing awareness of drought victims in Africa.

"It just seemed to me that this was a bill that had to pass and that I should do whatever I could to see that it passed," he said. "Running seemed, for me, to be the only way."

HE TOOK an eight-week leave of absence and six weeks' vacation from the postal service for the trip. He estimates he will have covered 3,000 miles by the time he gets to Washington, D.C.

Catholic churches are providing lodging for him at about 80 percent of his stops. Some post offices helped in the West, where towns are fewer and farther between.

Orange peel, grated	½ tsp.
Baking Powder	½ tsp.
Baking Soda	½ tsp.
White flour	1 cup
Whole Wheat flour	½ cup
Salt (optional)	½ tsp.
Nuts, chopped	½ cup
Raisins	½ cup

Method

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
2. Mix first four ingredients together well.
3. Fold in rest of items and stir just until blended.
4. Pour into greased loaf pan. Bake for 60 minutes or until toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean.
5. Cool in pan for 10 minutes before removing. Cool on rack.

NUTRITION IN QUESTION

Q: I'm interested in gaining weight and a friend suggested using a protein powder. Can you recommend a brand to use? Also, my friend recommended using this for breakfast and lunch in place of food and then to eat a normal evening meal.

A: Dear Donna,

If you are underweight, it will be helpful for you to gain to your ideal weight. Athletes who are underweight, may not have enough energy to work at their peak performance and some runners do have a problem maintaining their weight.

Weight is gained when your body takes in more Calories than your body burns. Gaining weight for some is not easy if you're training hard and burn up the extra Calories. Consuming extra protein will not increase muscle or strength. Extra Calories will produce weight and exercise causes muscle mass growth (and strength). Protein powders contain protein, a few other nutrients, and some Calories.

To gain weight and increase strength, you want to gain muscle. You can do this by increasing Calories and continuing to exercise. A wide variety of foods from the Basic Food Groups will provide additional Calories (while also supplying needed nutrients) and protein needs are usually met by increasing food choices from each group proportionately.

A pound of weight equals 3,500 Calories. So to gain a pound, you need to eat 3,500 more Calories than you burn for energy. To gain one to two pounds in a week, eat 500 to 1000 extra Calories each day.

Several ways to do this include:

- eating larger portions
- eat three meals a day
- include snacks more often
- substitute high Calorie nutrient-rich foods for low Calorie ones

Here are a list of foods rich in both Calories and nutrients and a recipe that will provide you with both.

Calorie and nutrient-rich foods:

- Nuts and nut butters
- Sandwiches
- Milk shakes and malts
- Dried fruits, fruit juices, jams and jellies
- Cheese & crackers
- Flavored yogurt
- Add dry milk powder to foods made with milk
- Pudding and ice cream
- Muffins and fruit breads

PRESIDENT'S COLUMN

****My last column...**

As I sit down to write my last column as President, I wonder where the year went? Not my most productive as a runner, but my most fulfilling year as a FWTC member. What do I mean by that? For years I was a FWTC member interested only in what the Club could do for me. But when Mike Robbins invited me to help out a few years ago, I quickly found out how rewarding it can be to help organize and carry out Track Club functions. My wife, Karen Bushey, deserves a "Medal of Honor" for putting up with me the last twelve months, especially during the three months leading up to the WMEF Marathon.

Normally, the President would list his accomplishments of the past year. Although much credit should go to all the Board Members who helped make my year as President so successful, I want to use this space to focus on what I see needs to be done in the future for the FWTC. As Mike Robbins pointed out in his article last month, the FWTC is entering a transition period. Here are my proposals I will ask the new President and Board to look at:

Cut expenses in the following ways -

- A. FWTC "Club Races" will have to cover its own expenses. The Hilly 4, 20K, and J. P. Jones 10K currently do cover costs. The One Hour Run did not;
- B. Abandon the points system - not enough participation. The annual awards are too

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
