



NUTRITION IN QUESTION

QUESTION: I always see commercials for soup. It's advertised as a "lite and nutritious" meal. However, when checking the labels, I notice that sodium seems quite high. What is your opinion?

Dear Anonymous,

You've brought up a good one as this question addresses several issues.

- Is the amount of sodium in soups excessive or unhealthy?
- Is soup "lite and nutritious?"
- How much sodium should we have in our diet, and how do we make concerned choices?

There is a lot of discussion about sodium in our diets as we hear doctors and health officials' warnings about the dangers of consuming excessive amounts of sodium. The Food Drug and Administration and other health professionals recommend that a sodium intake of 2,000 to 2,500 milligrams (mg) per day is a good target for healthy individuals. The amount of sodium in 10 ounces of prepared canned soup is 1,000 to 1,500 mg and prepared dry soups are usually higher. Therefore one serving of prepared soup could use over half of the daily recommended amount. This however, does not tell us if soup is a nutritious food based on its level of sodium. Let's look at some facts.

Sodium is a metallic element usable by humans only when combined with another element or compound. Its most common form is table salt (NaCl or sodium chloride), which is actually only about 40% sodium. Salt is rarely found in unprocessed foods but is used liberally in processed foods since salt is an effective preservative. Convenience foods and the fast foods American's love are often higher in salt content than the same items made at home. (See chart for sodium content of commonly eaten foods.) The average daily intake of sodium for Americans is 5,000 to 7,000 mg daily.

Although it's recommended we decrease the amount of salt in our diet, the case against salt is not ironclad. High sodium intake appears to be linked with hypertension. Yet of the 18% of the population with hypertension, only about half are sodium sensitive in which their blood pressure responds to the level of sodium intake. However, the fact is that population groups that consume a lot of sodium tend to have a high incidence of hypertension. It's felt that before hypertension develops it's possible to determine who is sodium sensitive and that the genetic resistance to sodium can be weakened by very high sodium intake over a lifetime and by other factors such as stress, cigarette smoking, obesity and age.

The concern over soup being "lite and nutritious" has nothing really to do with sodium content, but nutrient content. Most processed soups are not major sources of important nutrients. Use the nutrient information on the label (when available) to make decisions about what foods to serve with soups to get required nutrients at each meal. The enclosed recipe makes enough to freeze a portion for another meal.

Lentil Soup- serves 12

ingredient	amount	method
lentils	1 lb.	1. Combine lentils and water. Simmer for 30 minutes.
water	12 cups	
carrots, sliced	1½ cups

onion, sliced	1 cup
tomato juice	3 cups
parsley, minced	1 cup
oregano	1 tsp.

2. Add carrots, onions, garlic, tomato juice, parsley and oregano. Salt and pepper to desired taste.
3. Chopped ham or other left over meat may be added. Adding rice will complement the protein in the lentils.
4. Simmer all until carrots are tender.


It's been a busy May.

The MBE/Key Health Plan Marathon was a tremendous success. We had 2 new course records. The total number of participating runners increased with the addition of the BK Race. Everyone was happy with the new start/finish area in Johnny Applesseed Park. I want to thank Jim Bushey, Don Lindley and Chuck Debut for their invaluable assistance during the preparation for the Marathon and on race day. Without their help the Marathon and BK would not be possible.

After Marathon weekend, I went back to Elgin, Illinois for the 10th anniversary running of the Valley Fox Trot. I ran that race the first year, 1977, on Memorial Day morning, and return every year. The Fox Trot is a 10 mile course full of short steep hills. Aid stations are handled well by community volunteers and are set-up every three miles. After the race the awards ceremony is held in the basement of Hemmens Auditorium. There's plenty of water, Gatorade, fruit and beer (even though Hemmens is operated and owned by the city). Message tables are available, but you'll have to wait in line. Runner's can watch a videotape of the race before the awards. My first year of the Fox Trot was at the time when I resumed my running, after a 7 year lapse. I still thought I could run like I did in High School. When the gun went off I zoomed to the front of the pack and did the first mile at around 5:30. Shortly after reaching the first mile marker I was walking, gasping for breath and in pain. Seven years of inactivity had done considerable damage to my strength and stamina, not to mention all those parties. I finally finished just under 2 hours later.

Many of the people that ran the first year still come back. One is now the Race Director, Ray Moller. Ray runs the race every year and hands out the awards. In 1986 I set my best time, 1:22:36. This year I hoped to improve that mark, but finished with a 1:22:00. Maybe I'll do better next year.

Fort Wayne Track Club members participated in the first of 2 Torch Runs to go through Fort Wayne. This one was for the White River Games to be held in the summer. We ran the Torch from Freeman Square to Southtown Mall the afternoon of May 28. It was hot, but the pace was easy and the escort truck had water. Everyone had a goodtime talking and getting to know each other better. At Southtown Mall the Mayor and other dignitaries spoke. Then we enjoyed fresh veggies and Pepsi in the community room. You'll find information about the Pan Am Games Torch Run in another part of Inside Track.






