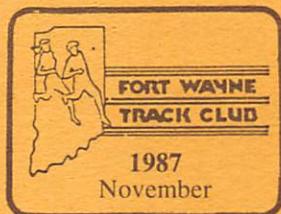

Open Letter to the FWTC

Recently I allowed my competitive energies to run amuck well after the finish of the Sports Tech 15k at Homestead. I do apologise to any friends that I might have offended by my concerns over the timing of the awards ceremony.

Whether or not I choose to "hang around" waiting for an awards ceremony is a personal choice. In the future I will make that choice without voicing my concerns and possibly offending others.

Certainly we all enjoy a very healthy track club and I'm proud to be one of those past administrators who helped find a direction for the club. As times change priorities change and maybe the purpose for certain issues is no longer relevant.

As a co-founder of several local races, an attempt was always made to serve these runners in every way possible. As the culmination of these events, it was assumed that the awards ceremony was the shining moment for the sponsor. Therefore, we hoped for the greatest participation possible by both participants and recipients. It was felt that the best way to accomplish this was to hold the ceremony as quickly as possible following the race. In a major race, such as a 10k, an hour and a half should be the planned for time barring any unusual circumstances. In a small race, such as the recent 15k, 1½ hours should be ample. I felt good about a race when as one of the early finishers, I had to worry about getting my warmdown in prior to the start of the awards. Timing of the ceremony will hopefully insure maximum participation by catching the majority before they have had a chance to go home.

The downside is that there will still be some runners on the course. I respect all the participants and in no way want to take anything away from each individual finisher. The fact remains that all runners are equal in their need to satisfy personal goals whether it's to win or just to finish. Simply based on sheer numbers, I'd rather risk having a few participants still on the course that lose those award winners you're trying to acknowledge because they simply couldn't wait around.

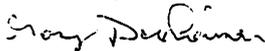
Frankly, I'm too busy to wait for over an hour to receive an award that I earned. Although I was wrong in my initial approach to this issue, I have found on two isolated occasions an attitude by race personnel and club administrators that I found disappointing. In the past I have found myself not able to stick around for delayed awards. In discussing this with the race director, I typically found a congenial host who was happy to share results and the award immediately. I got the distinct impression at the two most recent races that had the results been available, in no way would they have been shared with anyone prior to the ceremony.

I also find it interesting that in our computer age races scored manually during the running boom of years gone by typically had the results quite quickly versus typical delays in races with less participants, done by computer.

While I'm on my soapbox, one of the former administrative decisions that made me the proudest was numerous races with free entry to FWTC members and a pre-negotiated separate fee for members to other local major races.

The track club can be proud of its existance and those that unselfishly offer their time should be equally proud. Let's simply make sure that our priorities are in line with the uniqueness of our club.

NUTRITION IN QUESTION

Question: Could you please give information regarding the nutritional needs for runners who tend to have low blood sugar reactions (hypoglycemia)? Are there foods and drinks those runners should avoid at meals? What should runners with hypoglycemia do when carbohydrate loading for a marathon?

Dear Michael;

I can understand your concern for low blood sugar (hypoglycemia) reactions. Once blood sugar levels drop low (less than 70 mg of glucose per 100 ml of blood) a person can become overwhelmed by weakness, faintness, headache and confusion. Nutrition therapy is the main weapon against these symptoms.

Certain individuals are more sensitive to having hypoglycemic reactions. To be a true hypoglycemic, a glucose tolerance test is needed to test the body's response to food intake. This test is done after a physician's order. In healthy individuals, blood sugar levels will peak 1 to 2 hours after a meal. The pancreas produces the right amount of insulin to allow the blood sugar level to fall back to the normal range 2 to 3 hours after the meal. Note that it's the amount of insulin made by the pancreas that will determine the amount of blood sugar. Insulin allows body cells to take in glucose for energy production or storage.

Normal blood sugar 2 to 3 hours after a meal is 70 to 120 mg of glucose per 100 ml of blood. This range can vary depending on what test equipment is used. An individual's physician should decide what their healthy level is. It may be above the predicted normal range.

When a hypoglycemic has a meal, their pancreas does not respond correctly to metabolize carbohydrates. 2 to 3 hours after a meal, low blood sugar symptoms can occur. Instant help is needed. Feelings of anxiety and confusion can paralyze a person. To overcome the reaction, a simple carbohydrate has to be eaten, like $\frac{1}{2}$ cup fruit juice, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup regular soda or 1 T. honey. The symptoms should be gone after 15 minutes, but if not, another simple carbohydrate is needed. Call a physician if symptoms cannot be stopped. Once the symptoms are gone, a small meal should be eaten to prevent another reaction.

Modifying eating habits is important to avoid hypoglycemia. It is best to eat several small meals during the day. Ideally, meals should be eaten every 2 to 3 hours. This will help your body use food nutrients most efficiently. Large 1500 to 2000 calorie meals are tough for the body to handle. One surely will feel ill.

Hypoglycemic problems can also be solved by modifying food choices. Choose food combinations that will digest to blood sugar gradually. At all meals and snacks, match carbohydrate and protein foods. The meal plan has a variety of foods. Consider it not high, but moderate in carbohydrate content. Avoid concentrated sweets (simple carbohydrates), alcohol and caffeinated drinks due to their high chance of causing hypoglycemia.

Carbohydrate foods digest faster than protein and fat foods. If carbohydrates are eaten alone, there is a greater chance of low blood sugar symptoms after 2 hours. Simple carbohydrates (like juices and desserts) especially can cause problems. Complex carbohydrates (like bread, cereals and vegetables) can be used at meals.

It is interesting to note that fiber rich carbohydrates become blood sugar slower than low fiber forms. So choose whole grain breads and cereals at meals. Pass up refined white flour products when possible.

For a life free of hypoglycemia, think several small meals, by pass the sweets and skip the alcohol. It can help keep you feeling great. Mike, use the guidelines here for steady energy. Happy Eating.

Hypoglycemic Meal Plan Guidelines

1. Have a daily meal plan of 3 small meals and 3 between meal snacks.
2. Space out the meals and snacks evenly during the day. Eat every 2 to 3 hours.
3. Include a protein source at each meal and snack. The portion could be 1 oz. at snack and 2 to 4 ozs. at meals. Foods high in protein are: meat, fish, eggs, cheese, milk, yogurt and peanut butter.
4. Include a carbohydrate food at each meal and snack. Foods high in carbohydrate are: breads, crackers, rolls, bagels, cereals, pasta, rice, other grains, potatoes, vegetables and fruits.
5. Skip using concentrated sweets (simple carbohydrates) at meals and snacks. Concentrated sweets to avoid are: sweetened beverages, cake, candies, condensed milk, cookies, donuts, sweet rolls, honey, jam, jelly, marmalade, molasses, pastries, pies, popsicles, preserves, puddings, sugar, syrup, ice cream and sherbet.
6. Leave alcoholic drinks alone. If you are used to using alcohol, please take it with food.
7. By pass caffeinated drinks when possible.
8. Decaffeinated coffee, tea, or water are fine to use. For athletes, a good fluid intake is 8 to 10 cups per day.

When a hypoglycemic runner is preparing for a marathon, they can carbohydrate load the final 3 days before the event. I recommend the carbohydrate intake to be no more than 60% of the daily calories. Non-hypoglycemics can eat 70% carbohydrate meals. Regular hypoglycemic meals have 45 to 55% of the total calories as carbohydrate. Be very conscious of how you are feeling when eating more carbohydrates. You will definitely need to eat every two hours. Several small meals is very important. The main difference between regular and carbohydrate loading meals is the amount of protein vs. carbohydrate. I have included here a sample 3000 to 3200 calorie meal plan for hypoglycemia. This is an average calorie need for an active male distance runner. Carbohydrates are 50% of the calories. For carbohydrate loading, make these changes:

1. Drop all meat at breakfast and 1 ounce at dinner.
2. Drop 1 teaspoon margarine at lunch and dinner.
3. Add 1 slice bread, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup pasta, or $\frac{1}{2}$ cup cereal to each meal.
4. Add a small piece of fresh fruit at the morning and afternoon snack.

Sample 3000 to 3200 Calorie Hypoglycemic Meal Plan

Breakfast

1 oz. ham or 1 egg
1 whole english muffin or 2 slices wheat toast
1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups cold cereal
1 cup orange juice
1 tsp. margarine
1 cup 2% milk

Morning Snack

1 oz. cheese
12 crackers or 1 bagel
small apple or orange

Lunch

2 oz. turkey
2 slices wheat bread
1 to 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups vegetable soup
6 crackers
1 medium pear or banana
2 tsp. mayonaise
1 cup 2% milk

Afternoon Snack

1 oz. meat or 2 T. peanut butter
2 slices of bread or 12 pretzel rings
12 grapes

Dinner

3 oz. lean beef or seafood
1 cup pasta or medium potato
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup tomato sauce or peas
1 small roll
1 cup cooked broccoli or carrots
1 cup fruit salad
2 tsp. margarine
1 cup 2% milk

Evening Snack

3 to 4 cups popcorn
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup cottage cheese or 1 oz. meat
2 T. raisins or $\frac{1}{2}$ cup applesauce

Note: Each of the snacks are equal. You could use the afternoon idea in the morning or if it is easier, use the same snack each time you eat.

The nutrient amounts at the meals are approximately equal except for the meat serving. They can be interchanged too. What is important is controlling the carbohydrate content of each meal and snack.

Recipe of the Month

CHEESE FONDUE

8 ounces of low fat American cheese, cut into 1 inch cubes
½ cup skim milk
½ tsp. dry mustard
2 tsp. worchestershire sauce
1 tsp. onion powder
1 tsp. summer savory
2 Tbsp. dry sherry

1. In a large mixing bowl, combine all ingredients except sherry.
2. Microwave at medium 6 to 8 minutes, or until hot and smooth, stirring 2 or 3 times during cooking.
3. Blend in sherry. Serve with raw vegetables, breadsticks, or crackers.

May be prepared on stove. Cook stirring constantly over low to medium heat.

PLANTAR FASCITIS

Plantar fasciitis is one of the most common causes of heel and arch pain in runners. It is an overuse injury that involves an inflammatory reaction to the plantar fascia, a broad ligament that runs along the bottom of the foot from the calcaneus (heel) to the balls of the foot. In severe chronic cases, a heel spur may form.

The initial signs of plantar fasciitis are pain to the heel or bottom of foot with the first few steps in the morning. Another sign of plantar fasciitis is pain at the beginning of a workout that diminishes during running only to return after the run is finished.

The most common causes of plantar fasciitis are abnormal foot types such as excessive pronation (flat foot) which overstretches the plantar fascia. Excessive supination, which is a rigid high arched foot, also can produce symptoms because little shock absorption occurs. This results in a stretching at the site where the fascia attaches to the calcaneus.

Treatment of plantar fascia should have two objectives. The first is to decrease inflammation, and the second is to correct the cause of the overuse. Ice and anti-inflammatory medications such as aspirin or the variations of ibuprofen can be used as determined by your physician to decrease inflammation.

The second concern is to correct the problem. Stretching of the calf muscles and heel cord should always be included in this part of the treatment. Both straight knee and bent knee heel cord stretches should be initiated. Strengthening of the muscles that turn the ankle in and out as well as those that curl the toes should be included as well. Rest is often needed to fully recover from a severe case of plantar fasciitis. Decrease your mileage to your pain free limit and build up as tolerated.

The proper shoe is a vital part of preventing reoccurrence of this problem. Your running shoe should compensate for any biomechanical abnormalities you have. Occasionally, corrective orthotics may be needed to adequately balance the forces your foot experiences during running. Should you experience any of the signs of plantar fasciitis, you should consult with a professional who is knowledgeable in the biomechanics of running.

DANE MARTIN: A RUNNING TRIBUTE

Many of us in the Midwest running community were privileged to know Dane Martin, although very few of us ever saw more than the back of his singlet as he raced away from us as soon as the starter's gun was fired. Dane's preferred racing distance was from here to there: he was extremely competitive at distances from 1 mile to 100k, in both age group and open divisions. It was not uncommon for Dane to race several times in a single weekend, or for him to race a marathon one weekend and an ultra the next. These were not casual exercises for Dane: he entered with the intention of winning, and he ran to the intensity of the competition.

Each of us who raced against him has a favorite Dane Martin story. Mine dates from November, 1982, at the second FWTC Ultra-Marathon at North American Van Lines. I was looking for a hard 20-22 mile workout in preparation for an upcoming marathon. At the gun, I jumped into the lead and headed around the NAVL parking lot, down the small slope on Kroemer Road to the 1 mile mark. 6:04 and I had company: Dane was on my left shoulder. He passed me as we went up the hill towards the turn back into the parking lot. Dane, unfamiliar with the course, went straight as I turned into the lot. I reached the water table at 2 1/2 miles in 15:10. Dane got there in 16:00. I maintained a 6:05 - 6:10 pace for the next 17 1/2 miles. So did Dane. I quit at 20 miles, having accomplished several objectives: I had completed a hard workout, I had maintained a PR pace for 20 miles, and I had run from the front for virtually the entire distance. My margin over Dane at 20 miles was just over a minute and a half, the result of his failure to see the turn into the parking lot and his "walking breaks" every lap for fluids. Dane continued that pace for an additional 30 miles, completing the 50 mile race in just under 6 1/2 hours.

Dane brought a fiercely competitive spirit to his racing, but the lessons he shared go far beyond his victories on the roads. I do not know how Dane might have put into words his talent, self-discipline, dedication to training, and commitment to the pursuit of excellence in his racing. I would like to think he would let his races speak for him on these matters.

Racing is less a matter of reaching the finish line first than of confronting the personal challenge of striving for individual excellence. Dane brought that knowledge to his racing. I was a better racer when I raced against Dane, perhaps even a better runner for having known him.

Dane Martin, age 52, died on October 16, 1987.

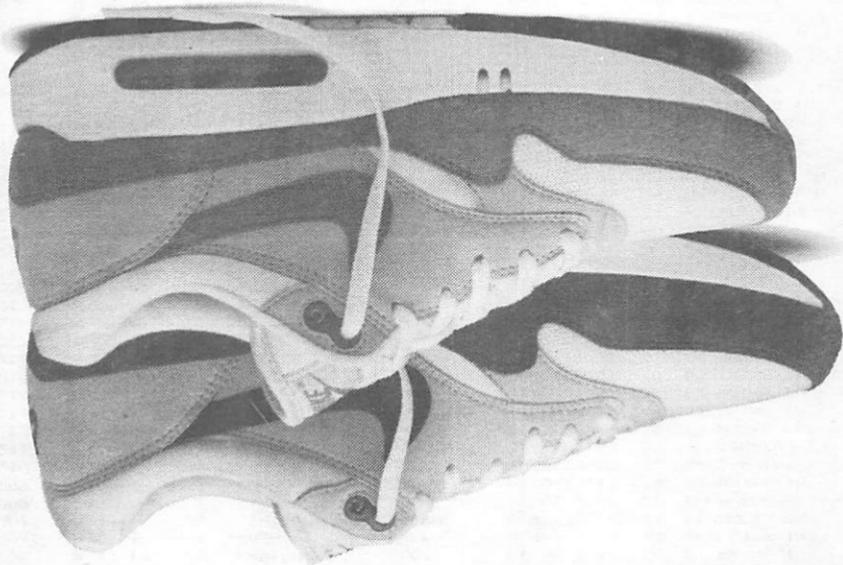

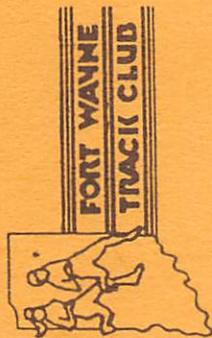
