# SLIM PICKINS

## BBQ

### LOW FAT BARBECUE

The typical BBQ meal - hamburger, two hot dogs and potato salad drenched in mayonnaise - does little to whittle your middle. "Easy Low-Fat Living" newsletter offers the following suggestions for a low-fat BBQ:

At 16 to 18 grams of fat for 3 oz., ground beef (ground chuck) is fatter than many other cuts of meat. Look for ground beef that's less than 10% fat and/or for ground round. For the leanest of burgers, select a lean piece of round steak from the meat case and ask the butcher to trim off all fat and grind the meat. The result should give you 5-6 fat grams per 3 oz. burger.

If you extend the meat by mixing it with other ingredients, you will cut the fat and cholesterol further and also meet some of your daily requirements for other types of food. Here are some ideas:

#### VEGGIE-BEEF BURGER:

Combine equal amounts of ground beef with shredded raw carrots or zucchini seasoned with Dijon mustard. You don't taste the vegetables but they add moisture and bulk.

#### CHILI-BEAN BURGER:

Add whole canned kidney beans (rinse and drain) and some chili powder to the meat mixture.

#### MUSHROOM BURGER:

Put the relish on the inside instead of the outside by adding chopped raw green pepper, mushrooms and onion with a dash of Worcestershire sauce to meat before forming into patties.

#### TURKEY BURGERS:

Use ground turkey or a combination of turkey and beef for a leaner burger.

#### ORIENTAL BURGERS:

Mix cooked rice and a little teriyaki sauce with ground beef—a good way to use leftover rice.

#### OTHER LOW-FAT BBQ TIPS

Skinless chicken breasts and seafood (tuna steak, swordfish, shark, scallops, and shrimp) are lower in fat than hamburgers and hot dogs. For maximum flavor, marinate 1-2 hours in the refrigerator.

### MARINADES:

Most marinades have no oil, hence no fat. Try teriyaki, soy sauce, fresh lime juice, salsa, white wine, mustard, or a combination. Brush some on while grilling, too.

### GRILLED VEGGIES:



Don't drown your veggies in oil or mayonnaise, grill them side by side with the meat. Cut zucchini, cauliflower, or red pepper into big chunks and brush or spray with oil (spray away from flames). Grill 3-4 minutes per side or until tender as desired.

### SHISH KEBABS:

A good way to use summer vegetables and keep meat portions to 3-4 oz. per person.

### FRUIT AND GRILLED CHICKEN:

Marinate chicken in a fruity vinegar (such as raspberry vinegar), and lemon, lime or orange juice and soy sauce. Grill or broil. Brush jam and mustard on. Garnish with fresh raspberries, strawberries, orange slices, peaches or pears.



### TWELVE FOR THE ROAD

Long road trips can be fattening. Not only are you sitting around all day, burning fewer calories, but the kind of food that's available at rest stops is usually high in fat. So bring your own food. It saves time (spent in line at a fast food stop), money and, most important, fat and calories. The following foods can be eaten for meals or snacks.

1. Bagels spread with yogurt cheese and topped with raisins or fruit preserve.
2. English muffins, stuffed with low-fat cottage cheese and smoked, sliced turkey.
3. Apple-honey-oatmeal muffins.
4. Fruit compote.
5. Taco shells filled with sliced bananas or strawberries and topped with vanilla yogurt.
6. Rice cakes or pita pockets with fillings. Try a salad made from cans of tuna fish, crab meat or shrimp with diet mayonnaise or yogurt and celery and herbs.
7. Vegetable or fruit kabobs.
8. Tomatoes stuffed with tuna or chicken salad.
9. Vegetable marinade.
10. Chicken-tomato-pasta salad.
11. Pita pockets stuffed with shredded lettuce, peas and cheese salad.
12. Assorted raw vegetables with cheddar and cottage cheese dip.


