HISTORY IN THE MAKING

President's Column
Indiana Tech Cross-Country
First Meet Experience

Let history record that on Friday, September 7, 2007, the Indiana Tech Warriors officially began competing in the sport of cross country at the annual Aquinas College Cross Country Invitational. Under the leadership of head coach Brad Peterson, along with assistants Barrie Peterson, Matt Blume, and Jenna Doerffler, the team boarded a bus bound for Grand Rapids, Michigan, at approximately 10:30 a.m. With new gear in tow and with "deer in headlight" eyes, the team was off to its first ever cross country meet. Excitement was definitely in the air!

The competitive team members for this historic occasion were as follows:

Women's Team—Alyssa Webb (Freshman from Lawrence Central H.S.); Brittney Howland (Freshman from Grandville H.S. in Michigan); Cristine Gulbranson (Freshman from Northrop H.S.); Kim Matusik (Freshman from Boone Grove H.S.); Felicia Mondry (Freshman from Grandville H.S.); Kara VanHorn (Freshman from Huntington North H.S.); Leah Blakemore (Freshman from Kearsley H.S. in Flint, MI); and Mika Davis (Freshman from Union City H.S.).

The team stopped in Jackson, Michigan, for a quick lunch stop at Subway. Some three hours from Fort Wayne, the team arrived at the meet site in Grand Rapids about three hours before the first race in order to have time to familiarize ourselves with the race course and to get loosened up after a long bus ride. Although the bus traveled through some pretty serious rainfall along the way, within an hour after arrival, the skies began to clear and the team was presented with a

fairly dry track. Unfortunately, with the end of the rain came some strong winds and heavy air, but even so, the conditions ended up being much better than the team and coaching staff had expected.

What an awesome sight it was to see IT emblazoned in one of the starting positions on the official start line. All of the hard work during the summer and pre-season training was about to actually pay off with our very first competition as a school. All of us were bombarded with questions about who is Indiana Tech and where is it located?

The men's race started at 5:00 p.m. with nine teams toeing the line and ready to go as the horn sounded (Grand Valley State, Aquinas, Indiana Tech, Lansing Community College, Siena Heights, Saint Xavier Univ., Cornerstone Univ., Olivet, and Holy Cross College). The Warriors were a little timid in going out, but managed to hang in there for a solid third place performance, good enough to earn them recognition as the number 4 ranked team in their Region, pretty good for a first year program comprised solely of 18-19 year old freshmen.

At 6:00 p.m., the horn sounded for the women's race (same teams except for St. Mary's College instead of Holy Cross). The Lady Warriors ran with no fear and captured a strong second place, defeating four of the nationally rated NAIA cross country teams in the process. This should place them high in both the Regional and National NAIA Cross Country Polls.

Following the competition, the runners completed their post-meet regimen, tore down and cleaned up the team camp location and boarded the busses for the long trip back to Fort Wayne, with a stop at Steak 'N Shake in Battle Creek on the way home. Boy, did we chow down! The team and coaching staff arrived safely back at Indiana Tech around midnight.

Almost all of the Warriors agreed that it was good to get that first meet under their belts; and they are now anxiously awaiting their next meet—the Indiana Intercollegiates at Purdue University—as history continues for this fledgling but talented group of Road Warriors!



September 12, 2007

1. The meeting was called to order by Barrie Peterson at 7:00 p.m. The opening devotions were given by Barrie. Refreshments were provided by Jim McKinnon. Opening prayer and devotions for October meeting will be given by Matt Parker. Refreshments will be provided by Mac McAvoy.

2. Minutes of the August meetings were approved unanimously pursuant to motion by Mac McAvoy and second by Don Lindley.

3. Treasurers Report was given by Don Lindley and reported membership of 506 compared with 516 in 2006 with 163 two-year memberships and 66 three-year memberships. The treasurers report was approved unanimously pursuant to motion by Tom Digate and second by Mac McAvoy.

Old Business:

Newsletter Information: September 15, 2007 is the deadline for submissions to the next newsletter.

Achilles Track Club: Jeremy reports an indefinite suspension of activities, subject to the availability of someone to take the leadership role. Achilles will remain on the website until February, 2008. Jeremy states further additional races may be possible, with beneficiaries to be Brain Injury of Indiana and Brain Injury of the United States.

Runners on Parade and Parlor City Report: Mac is very pleased with the success of *Runners on Parade* the future outlook is good in that Fort Wayne Orthopaedics has been signed as a major sponsor for 2008 and Mac is discussing possible major support from two other sources. Mac and Don submitted a seven page report on *Runners on Parade* with comparisons of expenses and revenue for the years 2004 - 2007.

As to *Par/or City*, Mac anticipates a total of 450 participants in the 10k and half-marathon, including walkers.

Mac moved that \$673.05 the mass mailing be split between the Track Club and Firecracker 4, with no expense attributable to Matthew 25. Sarah Kleinknight seconded this motion which passed unanimously. River City Rat Race Report: Don indicates that a total 57 participants have registered and that approximately 20-24 appear weekly for the

Rats in Training for the race. Because of construction at the water filtration plant, the course will be changed with a finish outside the Old Fort.

Riley 5 Mile Run Report: Nothing further to report as the race is still scheduled for Sunday, October 14, 2007. A brochure is available and the course has been approved. Net proceeds from this event will benefit Riley Hospital in Indianapolis.

Nutri-Run Race Director Report: Mike Thurston was present and introduced as race director. He advises no course changes are contemplated. Tammy is assisting in coordinating with the Chapel on accommodations and race date. The tentative suggestion of March 22, 2008 was mentioned. Barrie reiterated the commitment of the Board to provide resources and volunteer assistance to Mike in facilitating the race.

Board Members Race Duties Report: The outline of duties was submitted to Board members detailing various areas requiring volunteer assistance for all races in specific areas, such publicity, first aid stations and so forth. The Board is encouraged to email suggestions with respect to this outline. Further discussion was tabled to the October meeting.

Message Board Info and Update: Jed Pearson indicates that presently no decision is necessary with respect to Run Indiana and Board subsidy or assistance to that site. Jed indicates he will continue to consider his options.

New Business:

High School Cross Country Preview: Barrie reports that the cross country season is going well and the runners from Carroll, boys and girls, are state ranked. The Plex cross country course has been changed for the better, according to Barrie. There has been a request for the Track Club to provide chip timing for the SAC and the Cross Country Semi-State hosted by New Haven.

College Cross Country Preview: Barrie reported that IPFW has a good girls team, as does Indiana Tech, although new to the sport this year. The girls finished second to Grand Valley State and the boys were third, both teams finishing ahead of ranked teams in the NAIA invitational. Unfortunately, media coverage was spotty to nonexistent and the success were not reported in the NAIA rankings.

Progress Report on New Indoor Track at IPFW: The track is in its design stage and ground breaking is anticipated for mid 2008. Tom Bell is the new athletic director and it was suggested by Barrie that a get together luncheon with representative coaches and other interested individuals including Larry Lee and Barrie be scheduled.

Annual Banquet: Judy announced that the annual Banquet will be Sunday, February 10, 2008, in the IPFW Student Union with the usual time format: social hour at 5:00 p.m., welcome at 5:30 p.m. and Dinner at 5:40 p.m., with program to follow. Cheryl Braden is coordinator and it was suggested that the program consist of a panel including a coach, new fUIU1er and seasoned fUIU1er. The event would be catered in part, with desserts to be provided by Board Members.

Fanny Freezer: Scheduled to be February 9, 2008. The Board Members as sponsors.

Additional Matters:

It was suggested that Phil Bloom be given an award at the banquet for his past assistance in media coverage in the running community.

It was reported that Gary Bird has replaced Phil Suelzer for the Fort Wayne Community Schools Race for elementary students for the 1

mile event for 3,4, and 5th graders. Don moved that the Track Club contribute \$200.00 for awards for this event which was seconded by Mac and unanimously passed.

It was reported there will be no *Zoom through Zulu* for 2007.

Don reported that a new sound system costing approximately \$750.00 should be purchased. He noted that the budget already permits equipment purchases of \$5000.00 and this would be covered.

Motion to adjourn was made by Mac with a second by Don, which motion was unanimously carried and the meeting adjourned at 8:12 p.m.

Feed The Brain

The brain is absolutely essential to life! It is the main way for us to think, learn, feel, be happy, learn, process, memorize, reason, and perform. All aspects of mental, emotional, intellectual and physical health rely on brain functions.

How well do you nourish your brain? Before you think further, complete the questions and review the answers listed below.

1. Which of these foods are good sources of vitamin B12?
 - a. poultry
 - b. pinto beans
 - c. raisins
 - d. bananas
2. One cup of broccoli contains more vitamin C than an orange?
 - a. true
 - b. false
3. Which foods are good sources of vitamin E?
 - a. butter
 - b. walnuts
 - c. spinach greens
 - d. mangos
4. Which food can be considered fuel for the brain?
 - a. fish
 - b. cereal
 - c. cheese
 - d. peanut

Answers:

1. a. Poultry, B12 is found naturally only in animal products like milk, meat, poultry, Fruits, vegetables, and whole grains are supply many other vitamins, minerals, and phytochemicals, but not vitamin B12. **Vitamin B12 is important for all thinking, cognitive, and memory abilities. It also is involved in the production of neurotransmitters like dopamine and acetylcholine.**

2.a. True, Yes...one cup of broccoli does have more vitamin C than one orange yet oranges and other citrus fruits are excellent sources of vitamin C. Some other great sources of vitamin C are potatoes, tomatoes, berries, green peppers, and parsley. **Vitamin C acts as an antioxidant to protect brain cells, aids in wound healing, enhance iron absorption, and boosts immune system.**

3. b. walnuts, c. spinach greens, and d. mangos Most vegetable oils, nuts, seeds, colorful leafy greens, fortified cereals, and some fruits contain vitamin E. **Vitamin E is a key antioxidant to protect brain cells and other body cells. It also is involved in the production of red blood cells. Note walnuts and ground flax seeds also provide omega 3 fatty acids which contribute to better memory and nerve cells.**

4. b. cereal **Fuel for brain functions is derived from high carbohydrate foods like breads, cereals, fruits, and vegetable.** Meats, poultry, fish, and fats do not have carbohydrates. For steady brain energy and blood sugar throughout each day plan for 3 regular meals and 1-3 between meal nutritious snacks.

Plan for nutritious foods that are high in B vitamins, vitamin C, vitamin D, vitamin E, calcium, potassium, iron, omega 3 fatty acids, quality protein, and low processed carbohydrate food sources to feed the brain so it can function up to par. There is no definite evidence that any supplement or high dose vitamin will preserve or enhance brain activity. But there has been research to show healthy living steps can make a difference. Together nutritious meals/snacks, stimulating social connections, staying active, taking care of stress, proper sleep, and mental exercises (like reading, learning, puzzles, and games) can enhance mental and cognitive abilities plus delay brain deterioration. Know that what is healthy for the heart is healthy for the brain and will contribute to top performances.

Points Rules For 2007

- FWTC members must pay dues by March 1st to be awarded points for the current year. We will allow a grace period up to date of the Nutri-Run.
- Participants may earn 100 volunteer points for each race they work, with a maximum of 200 counting towards their total points. Volunteer points are not mandatory. Points may be earned for both volunteering and running in the same race. Race directors will earn 100 points toward the series; there are no maximum points for race directors.
- Age group placement:

- Age group placement is determined by your age at the start of the race year (January 1st). This is the group all your points will go into for the year.

Example: You are 44 on January 1st of 2007, in March you turn 45. Your points will continue to go into the age group that includes 44 until the end of the year.

- FWTC Age groups: Male and Female under 19, 20-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-69, 70 and over
- Some race directors opt to use different age groups than those of the FWTC. Points are earned based on that race's specified age groups. This means 2 people may earn the same points in one age group. Example: If a race director has a 60 - 64 age group and a 65 - 69 age group, the winners of each age group would receive 100 points. If the race director uses the FWTC age groups, there would be only 1 winner between ages 60-69. The FWTC board does not require race directors to use their age groupings.
- Points are given based on how a participant finishes compared to other FWTC members.




